Anderson - Johnson Engagement

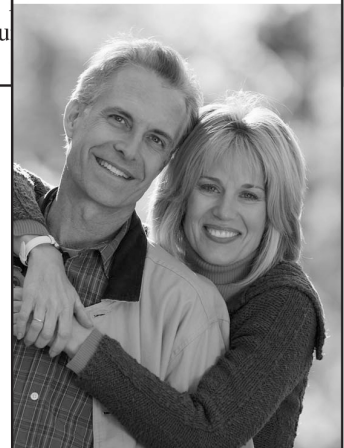
Kyle Anderson and Jennifer Johnson are excited to announce their engagement.
